Weavers in Germany.—The weavers are generally very badly paid, and particularly in some districts. For instance, silk weavers make from 12s 6d to 15s per week; but coarse linen weavers in the district of Bolkenheim only earn 2s 6d per week, and linen and cotton weavers in the district of Galtz from 3½d to 4¾d per day. It is difficult to understand how body and soul can thus be kept together, even with German frugality.
