
## Cord-cov'er-ing Ma-chine. A machine in

which a cord (or wire) receives a covering of thread or silk; when this is plaited on, it constitutes braiding. (See Braiding-Machine.) In the machine represented, the yarn-bobbins D D are upon carriers, and the yarn proceeds upwardly through the spindles C and the fiyer-bobbins F, which are sleeved thereon and carry the silk, which is twisted by the flyer around the yarn or cord from the spool D at a point below where it issues from the guide G. At a point above, the three covered yarns are twisted into a threefold cord or bullion.
