Laun'dry Stove. One for heating water and smoothing irons for laundry purposes.





Troy Laundry Stove.

The Troy laundry heater, shown in Fig. 1556, heats at one time 40 sad-irons or 80 polishing irous.

Another form has less capacity for irons, but has a large belt around it in which water is heated and whence it is conducted by pipes to the tubs.
