
Sat'in-et Loom. A loom designed for heavy goods, such as satinets, twills, jeans, satin stripes, checked cottonades, etc. It usually has 4 boxes at

one end. An endless chain governs and moves the heddle levers and is readily changed to any pat-tern without the aid of cams. It is of the open-shed type.
