VELVET, a rich kind of stuff, all silk, covered on the outside with a close, short, sine, soft shag, the other side

being a very strong close tissue.

The principal and best manufactories of velvet are in France and Italy, particularly in Venice, Milan, Florence, Genoa, and Lucca: there are others in Holland, set up by the French rasugees, whereof that at Harlem is the most considerable; but they all come short of the beauty of those in France.
