DESIGNS FOR LACE EDGING.

These two patterns are specially intended for trimming fichus and veils. The materials required are fine black Brussels net, crape, purse silk, and small bugles. In Fig. 1 the outlines are worked with black purse silk, partly in overcast, partly in satin stitch. The




outer edge is finished off with buttunhole stitch and purls, and the crape or net is cut away as

and puris, and the crape of net is cut away as directed by the illustration.

Fig. 2 is effected in a similar method; the net, however, is not cut away in any part of the pattern, and the small bugles are introduced as shown by the illustration.
