Web, n. [A. S. webb.] That which is woven; texture of threads; a sort of tissue or texture formed of threads interwoven with each other; textile fabric; hence, locally, a piece of cloth; as, to spin a web.—The filiferous texture spun by a spider. See Cobwer.—A dusky film, or suffusion, that forms over the eye and hinders the sight.—Among block-makers, the thin partition on the inside of the rim and between the spokes of a sheave.
