


Fig. 80. Insertion. See page 36




Fig. 81. Edging. See page 38






Fig. 84. Card Doily. Hearts. See page 40




Fig. 88. Edging. See page 42




Fig. 87. Card Doily. Clubs. See page 42




Fig. 89. Edging. See page 42




Fig. 90. Face Cloth. See page 42




Fig. 91. Edging. See page 43




Fig. 92. Edging. See page 43




Fig. 93. Edging. See page 43




Fig. 94. Doily. See page 47


