Job Description:

This position will report into Software Engineering Solutions and Services department, which is responsible for providing IT Engineering solutions to all software related disciplines within Raytheon Missile Systems (RMS). The Senior Information Systems Technologist I will have primary duties in the support of various Software Engineering tools and will be tasked with seeking out and implementing new operating efficiencies. Responsibilities include tool support in the areas of strategic planning, demand management, deployment, problem resolution, integration, customization and training. This individual will work closely across IT functions, Engineering and program personnel to develop and prioritize tool road maps, implementation and upgrade schedules for supported tools. The selected individual should be a self-starter with excellent critical thinking skills and the capabilities to identify, plan and implement tool automation and support requirements to continuously simplify and improve supported tools.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Experiences:

Must be eligible to obtain or have an active, DoD SECRET security clearance. Must have an INTERIM SECRET clearance before start date
